- 1. <u>Price</u> \$200 per person. Payment must be made by check or Money order made out to St. Francis Prep. Please make sure your name and ID # are on the check. Price includes entry to the prom and a 3 course dinner.
- 2. <u>Table Assignments</u> Students will be seated at tables of 10. If you wish to sit with certain people, you <u>must</u> fill out a table assignment form on the Prom webpage.
- 3. <u>Attire</u> The Prom is a formal event. Gentlemen must wear a suit or tuxedo with formal footwear. Ladies' dresses must be a respectable length and style. All outfits will be in accordance with demonstrating respect for one's self, one's family, and the SFP community. Mr. Ganci or Mrs. Ramsey have the right to refuse entry based on the appropriateness of attire.
- 4. All students must be in good standing with the Dean's office (outstanding detentions must be served) and the Finance office (must be up to date on tuition).
- 5. Students must arrive at the prom by 9:30pm the latest and must stay on premises. <u>All exits are final; there will be no re-admittance if a student leaves early</u>.
- 6. SFP has a <u>no-tolerance rule for possession, or use, of alcohol or any other substance</u>. To ensure the health and safety of all, students may be subject to a breathalyzer if there is any suspicion. Parents will be required to pick-up their child at event if such circumstance proves concerning.
- 7. Students may not bring any food or beverage, or carry any bags to this event. Small handbags are permitted and subject to search.
- 8. All those attending the Prom, Prep student or guest, <u>MUST</u> show ID to enter the venue (School ID or driver's license acceptable).
