

ST. FRANCIS PREP DRESS CODE 2013-2014

ALL CLOTHING IS TO BE NEAT AND CLEAN

All students must arrive at school in full dress code and remain in dress code until 2:45.

ALL STUDENTS

Uniform pants: must be purchased from Flynn & O'Hara and have SFP stitched below the pocket. Pants must be worn at the waist. Pants must be hemmed to a proper length. Uniform pant legs must not be tapered or altered to be *skin tight*. The width of the pant leg must remain relaxed-fitting. If students are wearing boots, pant legs must be over the boots.

Polo shirts: long or short sleeve, with the SFP logo, must be purchased from the uniform company or from the school bookstore and worn every day. **Undergarments must be the same hem and sleeve length as the polo.**

Sweatshirts, Sweaters or Fleece tops: with the SFP logo, must be purchased from the uniform company or from the school bookstore. **Every student must own one of these tops.** These are the only garments that may be worn over the polo shirt during the school day. **(Students must always wear SFP Polo at all times.)**

Shoes: All footwear must be solid black – shoes, sneakers, boots, no high heels. Footwear must not have any other color (no slippers, clogs or any other shoe without a back).

- All footwear that goes above the ankle must be worn under the pant legs.
- The overall appearance of footwear must be neat.

Outer wear: Coats, hats, jackets, scarf's, and any other weather-related items, including non-Prep tops worn over school clothing during cold weather months, **MUST** be kept in lockers during the school day.

Hair: must be neat and modestly groomed. Dye Color must be "*natural looking*" (Bright colors, including pink, blue, etc., are not permitted.)

Earrings: may be worn only on the ears. Tongue, eyebrow, nose rings, etc., are not permitted.

Please Note: The school has sole discretion in determining if a student's attire or appearance conforms to school standards. Students who do not comply with the above dress code will be required **to serve detention the same day they are out of dress code**. Students who repeatedly violate the dress code may be suspended from classes until they are in proper dress or sent home to change.
