## FOR CURRENT SOPHOMORES

# Your options are as follows if you have NOT taken the US History Regent:

#### SOC. STU. 8040 - US HISTORY, Z Period

This class takes place during Z Period at 7:45 am EVERY morning. It is limited to 70 students. Students MUST <u>pre-register</u> for this course. Students will be chosen in pre-registration order. Students with excessive lateness/absences or failing grades will NOT be allowed to take this course.

### SOC. STU. 8320 - US HISTORY

Any student who is currently enrolled in Global History II and does not apply for Z Period, Honors, or AP should choose this course during the registration period.

### SOC. STU. 8310 - US HISTORY, HONORS

Students who wish to take this course must have a minimum of a 92 average (88 if currently enrolled in honors.) Additionally, students MUST complete the <u>application</u>. The department chair will then determine based on application, teacher recommendation and transcript evaluation as to who will be approved for the course.

## SOC. STU. 8306 - AP AMERICAN HISTORY

Students who wish to take this course must have a minimum of a 95 average (91 if currently enrolled in honors.) Additionally, students MUST complete the <u>application</u>. The department chair will then determine based on application, teacher recommendation and transcript evaluation as to who will be approved for the course. Students are required to take the AP exam in May.

# Your options are as follows if you HAVE PASSED the US History Regent:

### SOC. STU. 8440 Economics AND SOC. STU. 8540 Participation in Government

Students who have passed the US History Regent in 8th grade and choose not to take an AP class MUST *pre-register* for these **two** courses.

## SOC. STU. 8306 - AP AMERICAN HISTORY

Students who wish to take this course must have a minimum of a 95 average (91 if currently enrolled in honors.) Additionally, students MUST complete the <u>application</u>. The department chair will then determine based on application, teacher recommendation and transcript evaluation as to who will be approved for the course. Students are required to take the AP exam in May.

## SOC. STU. 8426 - AP HUMAN GEOGRAPHY

Students who wish to take this course must have a minimum of a 92 average (88 if currently enrolled in honors.) Juniors applying for this course <u>MUST have passed the US History Regent</u>. Additionally, students MUST complete the <u>application</u>. The department chair will then determine based on application, teacher recommendation and transcript evaluation as to who will be approved for the course. Students are required to take the AP exam in May.
