## FOR CURRENT JUNIORS

Students must complete 1 credit of Social Studies in their senior year. You may take a full year course or two half year courses. Additionally, if your schedule allows, you may take an extra half year course.

**FOR ALL**: Students who wish to take this course must have a minimum of a 92 average (88 if currently enrolled in honors; 86 if currently enrolled in AP) Additionally, students MUST complete the <u>application</u>. The department chair will then determine based on application, teacher recommendation and transcript evaluation as to who will be approved for the course.
