Senior Final Exams: Final Exams in Physics, Honors Physics, Electronic Orchestration, AP Music Theory and AP Art History will be held on May 20 and 21. Your teachers will give you details including date, time, and room. All other final exams will take place in class during the final week of classes.

Summer School Registration: Senior level course registration will take place on 5/23 from 8:30am-12:00noon in the auditorium, immediately preceding graduation rehearsal.

If you are in danger of failing a course, please plan to be in school between June 3 and June 28. Classes will last several hours a day for 5 days. Dates for specific courses will be provided at registration. There will be a fee of \$315 for every senior summer course needed.

Graduation Rehearsal: Thursday, 5/23 at 10:30AM – Attendance for graduation practice is mandatory. At this time you will receive caps/gowns, diploma cases, invitations (momentos) and 5 tickets. Graduates do not need a ticket. If you need additional tickets you may request a maximum of 5 extra. Please submit your request to Mr. Mendolia via email no later than Thursday May 16 classes. This is a hard limit and a hard deadline.

Prom: 5/29 – Chelsea Piers, NYC. Please remember to have your ID with you. Your date should have identification as well. Students and

guests will not be admitted without their ticket and ID.

Graduation Liturgy: Friday, 5/31 at 9:00AM – Attendance for this service is mandatory. Parents are invited. Formal dress is required. This is Mass so there will be absolutely no yearbook signing. Following Mass there will be a non-academic awards ceremony. Breakfast will be held in the cafeteria upon the completion of the distribution of awards.
